

Steven S. Scherer, MD, PhD, is the William N. Kelley Professor of Neurology at the University of Pennsylvania. He received his BS (1977), as well as his MD and PhD (1985) from the University of Michigan. He did an internship in internal medicine (1985-86), and a residency in neurology (1986-1989) at the Hospital of the University of Pennsylvania. He was a Charles A. Dana fellow at the University of Pennsylvania from 1989-1991, and joined the faculty in 1991. He has been an author on more than 90 original research papers and 40 reviews. He is particularly interested in the structure and function of myelinated axons and the pathogenesis of inherited neuropathies.
